

CLEANING REAL WOOD WALLS BEFORE PAINTING

- 1. Use one of the following cleaning products:
 - ▼ TSP for regular cleaning of dirty surfaces only.
 - Simple Green ™ or Olympic Deck Clean ™ for wood surfaces with stubborn dirt or areas of graying wood.
- 2. Spray the walls with the selected cleaner according to the product directions.
- 3. Gently rinse surfaces with clean water using a garden hose (maximum 100 psi). Do not remove or separate the paint already in place, only remove the cleaning product completely.
- 4. Before the day of application, read the instructions on the container of the new tincture, they must be followed. Validate the color on a small section. The atmospheric conditions, the humidity of the wood and its preparation play just as important a role as the quality of the product and its application. Thorough drying of the wood before applying new stain is important. Usually, 24 hours without rain or dew is enough.
- 5. Stain application should generally be done at an outdoor temperature above 10 ° C. A minimum drying period of 4 hours should pass between applications.
- 6. In specific places where the wood is bare, it may be necessary to apply a first coat of stain locally depending on the type of finish in place in order to equalize the thicknesses and / or colors with the entire surface.
- 7. Then apply one or two coats of stain, depending on wear or specific need, across the surface. It is generally recommended that you finish a plank lengthwise to avoid overlap marks, especially with the semi-transparent stain.
