WIDTHS

NOMINAL 4"

Actual coverage widths vary depending on the chosen profile. Tongue and groove (stapled) or grooved (nailed) **profiles** are available.

Old Cottage style with rabbeted bevel and modern style with v-joint.

Higher installation cost due to slower installation progress and higher number of fastenings.

Increased stability due to more closely-spaced fastenings.

NOMINAL 5"

Exclusively for white cedar v-joints. Tongue and groove **profiles** (stapled) only.



NOMINAL 6"

Tongue and groove (stapled) or grooved (nailed) **profiles** are available.

A selection of the most installed models.

The most popular width in terms of raw material optimization, cost, style, aesthetics, easier installation, etc.



NOMINAL 8"

Limits the effect of grooves on larger surfaces.

Installation progresses faster.

Grooved **profiles** (nailed) only.

Models wider than 6" **require more closely-spaced fastenings**. The use of nails with heads is therefore required; they are fastened through the boards and spaced according to instructions.
